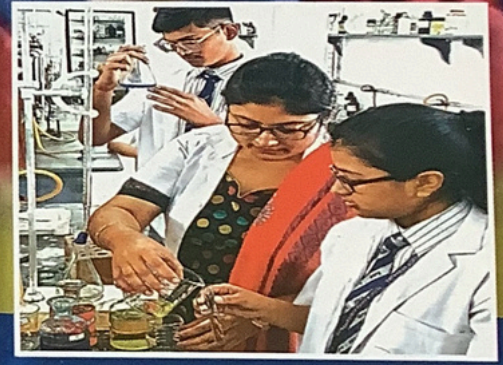

- Year of Inception** : 1984
- Affiliation** : The school is affiliated to the Council for Indian School Certificate Examinations for both class X and XII examinations.
- Streams** : Science , Commerce and Humanities streams available for Classes IX, XI and XII.
- Curriculum** : Adequate curriculum is prescribed for Classes I to VIII. For Classes IX-XII, the curriculum specified by the CISCE is followed.
- Assembly** : 8:15 am - Class Lower Nursery to Class XII

SO, WE MOVE WITH A VISION TO:

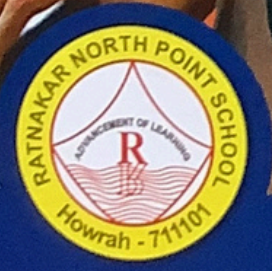
- Establish a secure and positive environment for all staffs and students.

- Fully equipped and air conditioned computer laboratory with high speed internet connection.

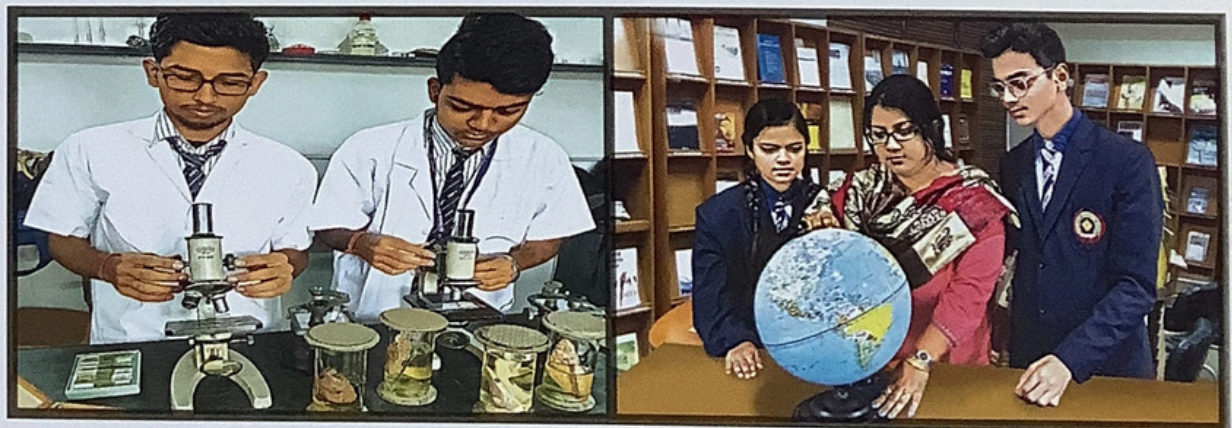
- Fully equipped, functional & independent Physics, Chemistry and Biology Laboratories.

CO-CURRICULUM:

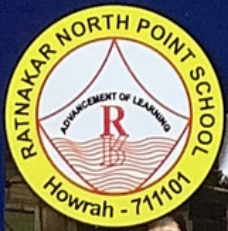
The extracurricular activities are given special preference and students are encouraged to take part in various activities under supervision.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES OFFERED BY US:

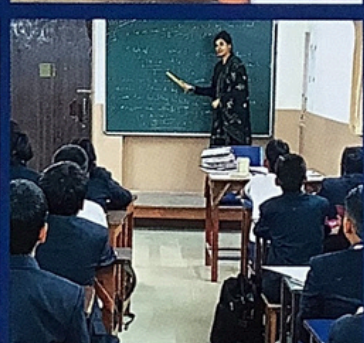
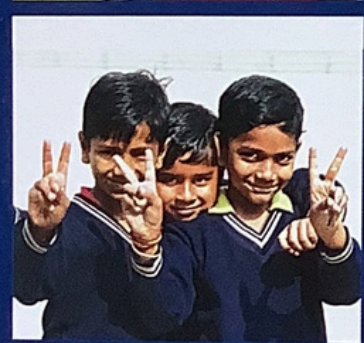
- Oratory skill through elocution, debate, declamation and group discussions.

FACULTY:

Elementary Classes – I to V

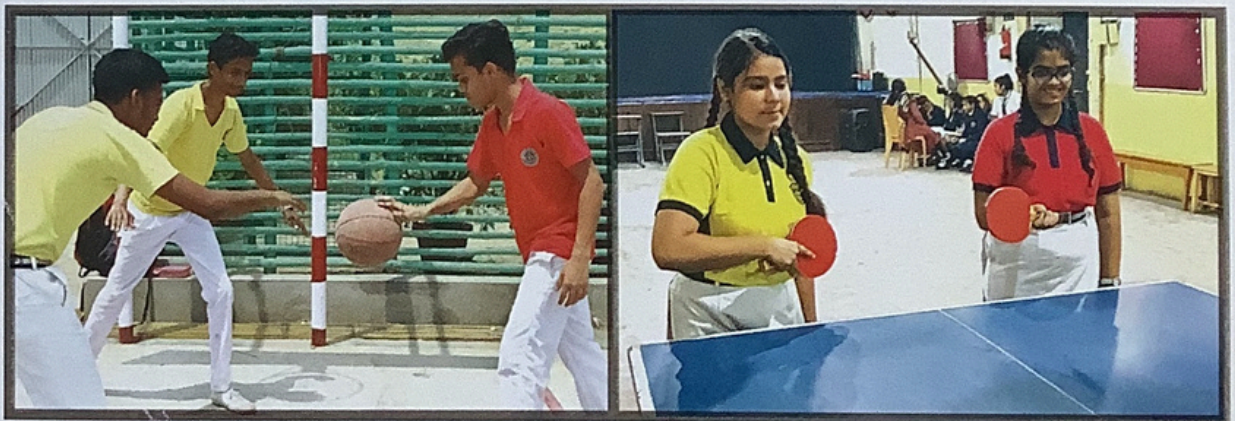
Middle School – VI to VIII

Senior Secondary – XI & XII

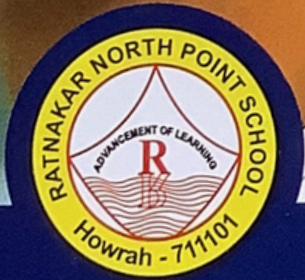
The curriculum divides into two streams in class IX – 'Science' and 'Commerce'.

- Important School Personnel** : The School Principal, Vice - Principal have combined work experience of over 20 years. All teachers are appropriately qualified, experience and dedicated.
- School Uniform** : All uniforms are to be purchased from the school tailor.
- Fees Regulations** :
 - Pupils will not be permitted to sit for any examinations, if the fees have not been cleared up to the current month in which the examination will be held.
 - If fees are not paid by the 15th of each month a fine of Rs.10/- (Rupees ten only) has to be paid. Pupil whose fees are over three months in arrears will have their names struck off the roll automatically without prior notice and may be re-admitted on payment of arrears and a re-admission fee.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Step 1** : Collect Prospectus and Registration forms from reception.
- Step 2** : Schedule appointment for an interaction interview if required.
- Step 3** : Wait for results on school notice board.
- Step 4** : If admission is granted, collect Admission Form. Fill in the Admission Form, and submit required documents to the school office. This is to be done within the validity date mentioned on the Admission Form after which the form would have lapsed. Admission Fees to be paid in the name of 'Ratnakar North Point School'.

Following is a list of ATTESTED DOCUMENTS which will be required during admission procedures:

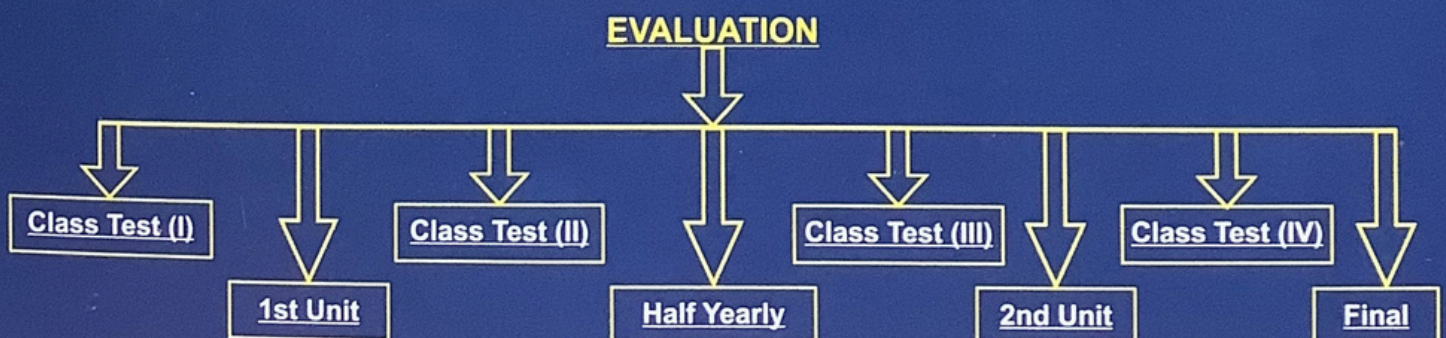
- Birth Certificate (Original to be produced and duplicate to be submitted).
- Progress Report of previous school attended.
- Transfer Certificate of previous school attended (Original).
- Migration Certificate where applicable.
- 2 passport size photographs of the student & parents.

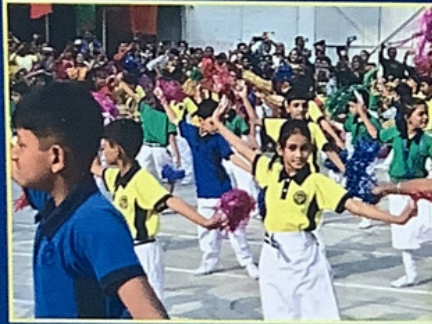
GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS:

- Guardians are expected to check school diary regularly.
- Guardians are requested to take part in seminars and other functions arranged by the school.
- Guardians should attend parent teachers' meeting for proper evaluation of their students.
- On the day of examination, if a child is unable to attend the school, because of illness or any unavoidable circumstances, the information must reach to the office on the same day with assisting documents.
- If a student is absent for a long period of time, parents are requested to send an absent letter to school with supporting documents.
- Guardians must ensure that their children come to the school in proper, clean uniform.
- Guardians are also requested to check the exercise books of their children from time to time and keep a track of their classwork's and homework's.
